



# PERMIT CHECKLIST

Many home improvement projects require a permit. Permits allow the city or county to inspect your property to ensure the building will be safe.

## YOUR PART:

- ✔ **Select your shed and purchase** (or have it quoted) BEFORE applying for the permit.
- ✔ **Put yourself down as the contractor.** Westwood Sheds is a manufacturer, not a contractor so we cannot pull permits.
- ✔ **Specify that your shed is a PORTABLE building** (on the permit application)
- ✔ **As the homeowner,** you assume responsibility for the project when the permit is issued.
- ✔ **Important items to think about:** Size restrictions, anchor requirements, setback requirements.

## OUR PART:
